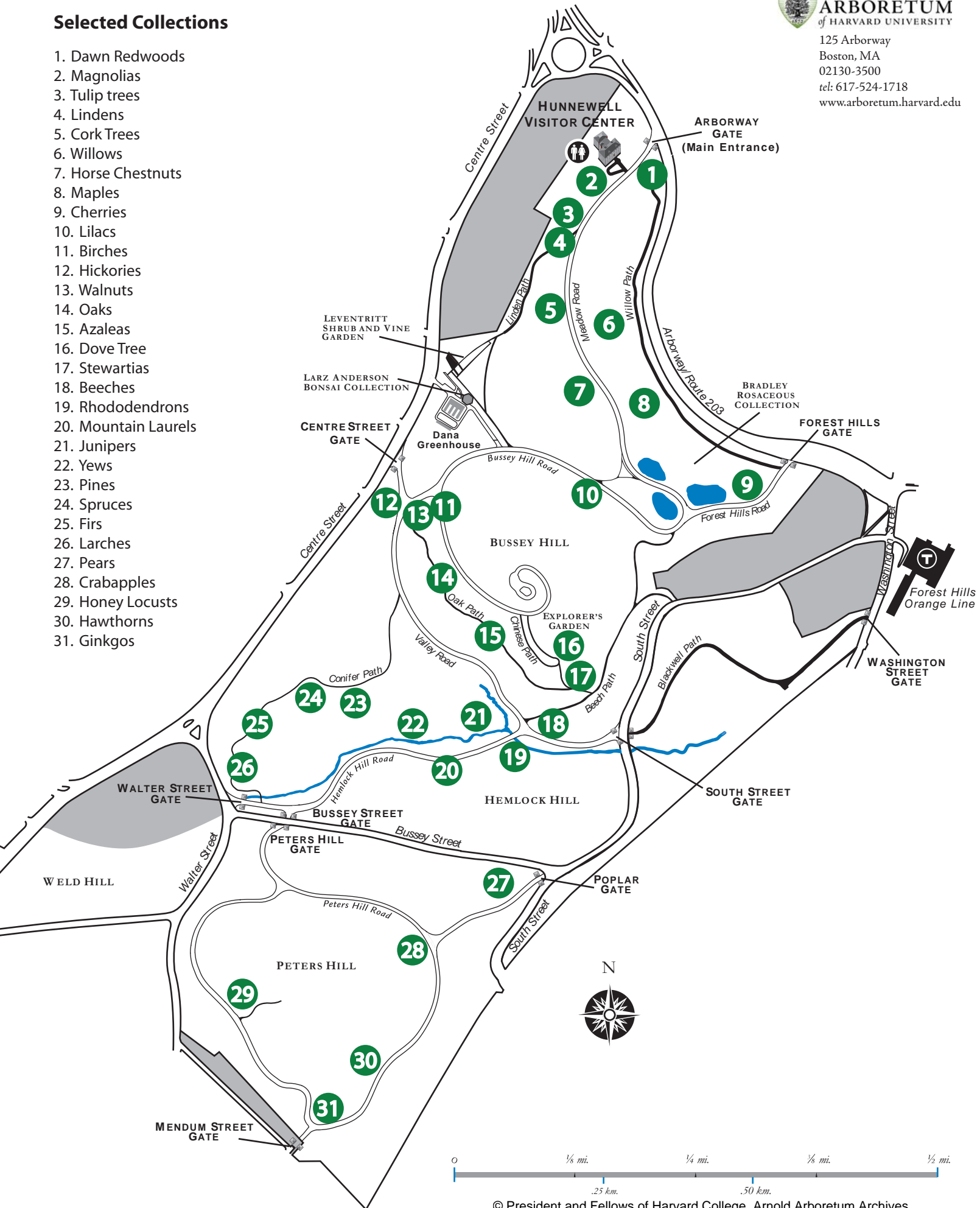

Take a Walk in the Arboretum

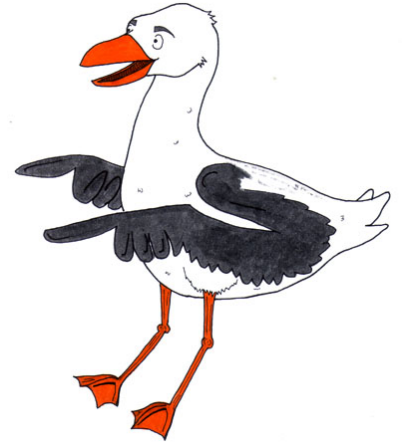
The **Arboretum** is a large park in Boston that is planted with many kinds of trees. Herry loves to visit there. There are many pathways in the park. People love to walk through this park to see the different trees.

Look closely at the big map of the Arboretum.

There is a **map key** to show you what is planted in the park. Each kind of tree has a number.

Maple trees are number **8**. Look for **8** on the map. That is where the maple trees are planted.

Herry's favorite tree is the Ginkgo. Where can you find ginkgo trees in the park?



People use the map of the Arboretum to plan a walk through the park to see different trees. Use the map to plan these walking tours. Trace the path you will take on the map with your finger.

- ⇒ Enter the Arboretum through the Centre Street Gate. It is on the west side of the park. Make a plan to see the Dove trees, then the Pine trees, and then the Crabapple trees. Leave the Arboretum through the Poplar Gate on the East side of the park.
- ⇒ Enter at the Main Entrance, the Arborway Gate. Make a plan to see the Willow trees, the Cherry trees, the Azaleas and the Yews. Which gate will you use to leave the park?
- ⇒ Enter at the Poplar Gate. Go to see the trees marked **29**, **27**, and **23**. What trees will you see? Pick one more kind of tree to add to your walk. Then make your way back to the Poplar Gate to leave the park.
- ⇒ Make a plan to enter the Arboretum through the Washington Street Gate, and leave through the Centre Street Gate. What trees do you want to see? What path will you take? There are many ways to walk across the park!
- ⇒ Now make a plan for a walk through the Arboretum with a friend.
